Riley Turner was born February 21, 2008, and from birth, she has been a very medically complex child. She has an undiagnosed neuromuscular disease which necessitates a tracheostomy tube requiring 24-hour attention and a gastrostomy-jejunostomy tube for feeding and medicine. Group insurance benefits for medical equipment and nursing care services have been exhausted and government programs are not available.

To help cover her ongoing medical expenses, Riley's extended family is sponsoring a Walk/Run for Riley as part of "The Human Race", a 5K Walk/Run and 1 Mile Fun Run promoted by HandsOn Jacksonville and the RITA Foundation, the umbrella organizations for the event. All pledge money raised flows through The RITA Foundation and is returned 100% to The Riley E. Turner Special Needs Trust Fund.
